



Exams Information

Headteacher, Elizabeth Dakin, praised the efforts of staff and students on their results in the summer of 2018.

The key figures were as follows (based on invalidated data, correct to 3rd September 2018):

KS4 – 2018

The school's Progress 8 figure was -0.07 in 2017. The figure for 2018 is anticipated to be 0.00.

The school's Attainment 8 average score was 4.58.

64% of pupils achieved a standard pass (grade 4 or better) in both English and Maths, with 37% achieving a strong pass in both (grade 5 or better).

34% of pupils achieved the English Baccalaureate with standard passes in English and Maths, demonstrating strong performance across a suite of academic subjects, including a Modern Foreign Language. This is anticipated to be significantly above the national average. The figure is 20% with strong passes in English and Maths. The EBacc. Average Points Score was 4.09.

In addition:

61% of pupils achieved 5 or more standard passes including English and Maths.

34% of pupils achieved 5 or more strong passes including English and Maths.

98% of pupils achieved 5 or more passes.

100% of pupils achieved at least one qualification.

For A Levels only:

19% of grades were A* – A.

39% of grades were A* – B.

96% of grades were A* – E.

88% of students went on to further education, training or employment in 2015 (latest available data).
