Year 10

Students will begin the new GCSE RE syllabus. They will complete two examinations worth 50% each.

Unit 1: Religion and Ethics. Students will study topics on Belief in God, Marriage and Family, Living a Religious Life and Matters of Life and Death from a non – religious and religious (Christianity) perspective

Unit 2: Religion, Peace and Conflict. Students will study topics on Belief in God, Crime and Punishment, Living a Religious Life and Peace and Conflict from a non-religious and religious (Islam) perspective

Year 11

Students are finishing the old GCSE RE syllabus. At the end of year 11 they will complete two examinations worth 50% each

Unit 1: Religion and Life: Topics studied include: Believing in God; Issues of Life and Death; Marriage and Family life; Religion and Community Cohesion

Unit 2: Religion and Society: Topics studied include: Rights and Responsibilities; Environmental and Medical issues; Religion, peace and conflict, Crime and Punishment
