Headline Information

- The percentage of school leavers meeting the duty to participate (in full time education, training, apprenticeships and full time employment with education) has been above the county and national average for the past two years.
- The vast majority of our students continue on to full time education and attend a range of Post 16 providers (90.7% in 2017).
- Around 4% of our students go on to participate on apprenticeships schemes over the past two years (above the county average).
- The schools NEET percentage (those students not in education, employment of training) has been consistently below the county and national average suggesting that students are well informed and make appropriate choices.
