

Year 7 Catch Up Grant

The school receives £500 per pupil for each pupil in Year 7 who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or mathematics at Key Stage 2 in 2013 Key Stage 2 assessments. The school received **£28,000** in 2013-14. In the 2014-15 academic year we predict a grant of **£17,500**. This money allocation contributed to:-

- Numeracy Intervention:- SuccessMaker, MyMaths, Revision Guides, Catch Up Intervention, TA targeted support, 1:1 Maths Mentoring, Mangahigh Computer based learning, Mentoring.
- Literacy Intervention:- SuccessMaker, Intervention Packs, 1:1 Tuition with KS3 Intervention Co-ordinator, Dockside Reading Programme, Paired Reading, Spelling Homework, Reading Rulers.
