#### Headline Information

- The percentage of school leavers meeting the duty to participate (in full time education, training, apprenticeships and full time employment with education) has been above the county and national average for two out of the three previous years.
- The vast majority of our students continue on to full time education and attend a range of Post 16 providers.
- Around 5% (per year) of our students go on to participate on apprenticeships schemes (above the county average).
- The schools NEET percentage (those students not in education, employment of training) has been consistently below the county and national average (except 2017) suggesting that students are well informed and make appropriate choices.
