A calculator will be provided for your maths exam ONLY. Equipment needs to be in a clear plastic bag or pencil case. Water (only) should be in a clear, unlabelled plastic bottle. Food is not permitted in the exam hall. Mobile 'phones should be turned off and handed in at the start.
- If you have an entitlement to extra time all of your examinations will be in N8.
- We have the highest expectations of behaviour in all examinations – you must not communicate once inside the hall until you leave the building and you must raise your hand if you require assistance from an invigilator.
