

Year 12 - English Language and Literature

Type of learning tasks:

HLJ: Voiceover powerpoints for annotation of texts. Youtube masterclasses, interviews with author, class discussion on TEAMS posts.

KRK: Revision resources on youtube and digital platforms until poetry is finished then NEA powerpoint.

Content:

AQA A Level: English Language and Literature: Paper 1: Handmaid's Tale and Duffy Mean Time poetry. Then NEA preparation if we are not back.

Resources:

Texts and anthologies for each area of study were given out before lockdown. All exam questions and powerpoints uploaded onto files on TEAMS for students to access. Students are completing tasks in assignments and through general 'posts'

Feedback expectation:

Students will send in essay word documents for assessment and feedback through Microsoft Teams. So far, one essay set and feedback for Handmaid's as we are completing the novel through annotations. Students are sharing their annotations through TEAMS posts. Students receive AO annotations and a graded response.

Timescales:

Timescales for tasks are clearly set out on Teams in both the assignments and general 'posts' section. Students set work on a daily basis so expectation is to complete annotations that day. Essays have a weekend timescale to allow flexibility for completion.
