- **Period 1-2 exams:** You MUST be at the top end of the tennis courts for 8.45am – register and go straight out (you do not need to wait for end of registration bell). **Period 3-4 Exams:** You MUST be at the top end of the tennis courts for 11.15am. Exams start at 11.30pm.
- Please **bring all necessary equipment** for the exams. This includes, pens, pencils, rulers, calculators and erasers. You should write in BLACK ink. A calculator will be provided for your maths and Science exams ONLY. Equipment needs to be in a clear plastic bag or pencil case. Water (only) should be in a clear, unlabelled bottle. Food is not permitted. Mobile ‘phones should be turned off and handed in at the start and if you bring your own calculator then the cover/case should be removed.
- If you have an entitlement to extra time all of your examinations will be in a separate room and you will be advised of this beforehand.
- We have the **highest expectations of behaviour in all examinations** – you must not communicate once inside the hall until you leave the building and you must raise your hand if you require assistance from an invigilator. If are reported by an invigilator because your behaviour falls below expectation you will receive a pastoral detention and a formal letter home. If this happens a second time you will receive an after-school detention. Please ensure that your behaviour is perfect at all times.
- You must **not enter the Lamont or Ruscoe Centre** when at the Sixth Form and should only use the toilets attached to the Stanier Hall.
