Dear parents/guardians,

We would like to present your child with an opportunity to experience an educational visit in the summer to explore Shakespeare's London. Not only will this be a fantastic opportunity to experience a range of cultural and historical visits around the capital, it will provide students with a helpful insight into the world of our most famous playwright, whom they must study at GCSE English Literature.

The visit will run from Tuesday 19th July to Thursday 21st July 2022, and will involve two overnight stays at Bankside Accommodation in a fantastic location, right in the centre of London, just a short walk away from the Globe Theatre. We will leave school at 9.00 am on the Tuesday and return approximately at 7.00 pm on the Thursday.

The visit will cost £322, and we would ask that the initial, non-refundable deposit of £122 is paid no later than the first full week back in September – Friday 10th 2021, although the places will be given on a first come first served basis. This should be paid through Parent Pay, and the trip slip handed in to the English Office. There will then be two more deposits, the first of £100 and the second of £100 required by November 25th and February 11th respectively.

The visit's itinerary will include a trip to the British Museum, a walk around TheatreLand at Covent Garden and a 2 course meal at Pizza Express on the Tuesday, before going to watch a West End show. On the Wednesday, breakfast is provided before spending a day at the Globe theatre, fitting in a guided tour, a visit to the Victoria and Albert museum, and a Shakespeare workshop. A packed lunch is provided before heading out for dinner and taking in the show at the Globe Theatre. The final day will include a tour of Shakespeare's London and a visit to the Tate Modern, before heading home after lunch.

All meals and accommodation are provided for in the cost.

This fabulous visit is limited to 45 spaces, which will be allocated on a first come first served basis, although students demonstrating very poor behaviour in school will not be considered due to safety concerns.

Please send your reply slips in to the English Department and deposit via parent pay by September 10th to ensure a place. If you are eligible for free school meals then please speak to one of the named teachers below to discuss how we can support you with payment towards the trip.
