

# Summer School Review August 2021

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## Background and Intent

Thomas Adams Summer School took place between Monday 9<sup>th</sup> – Friday 13<sup>th</sup> August. The goal of the Summer School was to provide the upcoming Year 7 students with a week's transition activities with the goal of making the transition comfortable, alleviating anxiety in students and a focus on skills to support students' future learning, in particular looking at developing careers related skills such as teamwork and presenting.

Then financial breakdown of the event can be found at the back of this document.

## Executive Summary

- Overall we provided 569 places over the 5 days for students. We had 648 students sign up and additional turning up, this is the figure we will claim for in our finance document.
- Surplus of £10,103.76 from the Summer School.
- 84 students attended all 5 days with just under ¼ increasing the number of days they were due to attend throughout the week.
- High satisfaction scores from students for variety of lessons and a rating of 4.54 / 5 for the overall quality of the experience. The theme of chocolate proved popular with 24% of students mentioning chocolate in their answer. The School met its goal of supporting student's transition with 103/113 saying it improved their confidence in starting.
- High satisfaction with parents, almost all students said it helped with their child's confidence in starting a high satisfaction score, one who replied it wasn't, that doesn't fit with other comments they made on the form. Parents rated the experience as 4.76 out of 5 stars. Most negative comments said they were dealt with quickly and effectively by Hannah Lester, Head of Year.
- Staff feedback was positive, with those involved happy with their impact on transition and happy with the organisation.

## Lessons and Themes

The Summer School's lessons predominantly followed the theme of designing and branding a chocolate bar, similar to enterprise challenges we hold in year 9. The following lessons were taught during the week.

### Questions 2 - 4 analysis

Nearly 3/4s of students attended all 5 days with 23 out of 112 students increasing the number of days they attended. We can conclude from this that the students enjoyed themselves during the week to the extent they were willing to attend additional days. In question 5, 95% of students enjoyed the variety of activities held during the week.

The results of question 5 show that students rated Summer school highly in terms of enjoyment. As a staff we can be proud of the lessons and learning that took place during this week.

Question 6 - What was your favourite part of Summer School?

24% of responses related to the word chocolate in some manner, the results suggest that the theme of the Summer school was popular. Other key phrases included cooking, PE. It was pleasing to look at the results and see the social aspects of Summer school getting mentioned frequently, including making new friends and meeting their new teachers. This shows that our goal of supporting with the social aspects of school was met.

Question 7 - What was your least favourite part of Summer School?

There was no overriding theme to the answers to this question. Some disliked the short first break which was originally designated as a toilet break and nothing more. Some students disliked sitting in one classroom as their base, this was true for the first day but then there was quite a bit of moving around.

Question 8 – 91% of students felt more comfortable starting at the school then they did before the start of Summer School. I am disappointed with the 3 who do not feel more confident, when looking at what they rated Summer School, they gave them 3,4 and 5 which suggests that at least they enjoyed the experience and may be more representative of their confidence than their experience.

Question 9- What else could we have done to make Summer School better?

The main response was about the lack of chairs for lunch or for longer breaks. All things which you would expect due to changes made from COVID.

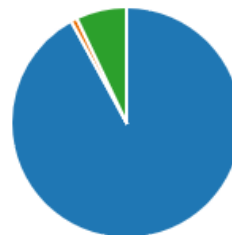
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#### 10. Would you recommend Summer School to a friend?

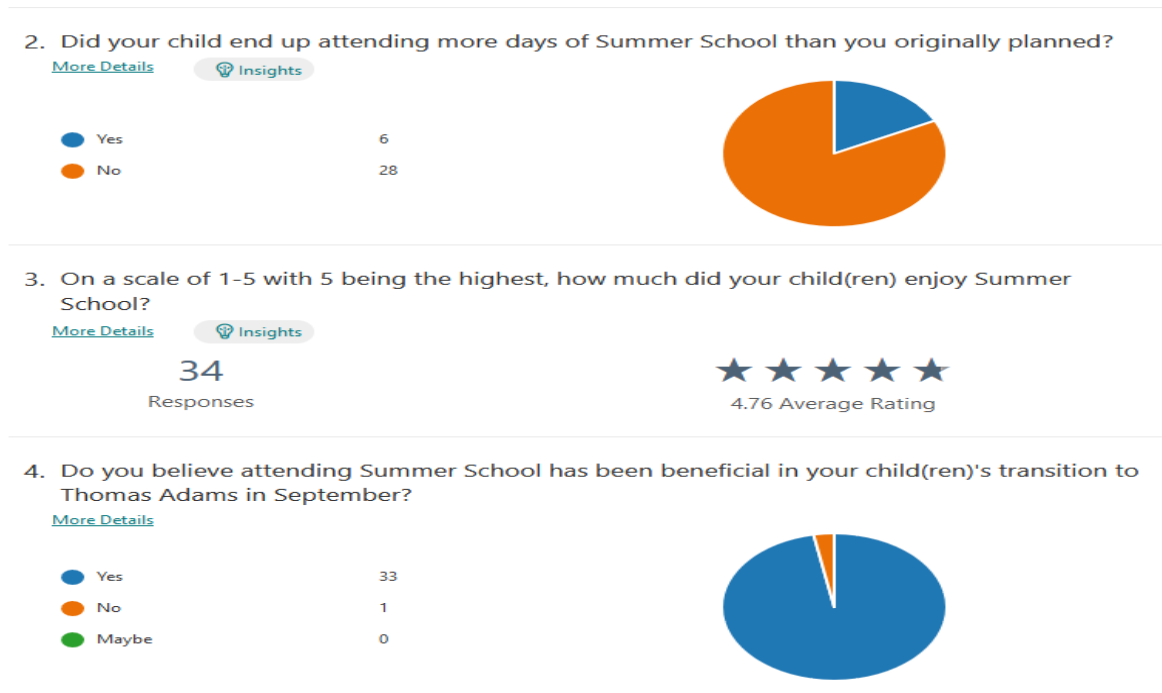


Overwhelmingly positive responses to this question with 92% of students saying they would recommend Summer School and only one student who would not, however, that student gave 5 stars for the enjoyment question.

## Parental Feedback



Question 2 mirrors the answers given in the same question as was posed to the students, showing that some parents were pleased with their experience that their students completed more days than they originally expected to do so. In question 3 parents rated Summer school highly, with a score of 4.74. This shows they rated it higher than the children but may be impacted by the lower number of parents who completed the survey compared to the students. Regardless, the school should be proud of a very high satisfaction score. Question 4 has parents overwhelmingly believing that Summer School was beneficial to their child's transition – with 97% answering yes. This again proves that we met our main target with Summer School.

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Question 5 – the overwhelming responses (88%) believed the event was planned extremely well, and 9% quite well. The 1 response that was poor can be claimed to be an accident as they gave the experience 4/5 and the comment thanks the school for the experience. Question 6 reinforces the positive experience with the majority of parents saying they would send students again.

Question 7 - Any other comments or feedback on Summer School would be greatly appreciated.

Overall the responses were positive, even those that were negative were turned positive by speaking to Miss Lester, HOY. This is a credit to her diligence and care for the pupils. Most of the comments talked of how the students felt more confident following their time at the school.

Question 1 shows that staff were happy with the organisation of the Summer School and that with a rating of 4.85 out of 5. This is pleasing to us and helped foster the sense of community that we hoped to instil within the staff involved. Overall staff were fairly confident of the lessons they were teaching, this can be explained by the distributed leadership model relating to the lessons where staff with certain specialisms were asked to plan the lessons. Question 3 highlights how information was shared with staff, again the results rated this highly.

Question 4 confirms that we shared information well during Summer school, I feel that the reason for this high score was due to daily briefings, which were of course necessary due to the rotation of staff. Question 5 shows that staff felt supported during the Summer school, this is no doubt due to Mr Gough visiting each class during each lesson. Question 6 shows that staff noticed the beneficial nature of Summer school, both in terms of preparation for year 7 and the social benefit.

Question 7. Any other feedback that you wish to share?

Comments were positive with the staff realising the importance of the event to supporting students in their transition. One area to consider is that teachers need to introduce TAs to the students.

## Overall Comments

- Overall the Summer School was a positive experience for all involved with students, parents and staff all extremely happy with the event and its outcomes
- Parents and Staff were pleased with the organisation
- One point to consider would be length of breaks and dining arrangements
- Would recommend holding a Summer school in the future if the COVID fund continues next year as the benefits seem to be worth the work.
- Theme of chocolate was popular and majority were pleased with the lessons.
