Notes to Students:

- There are TWO exam sessions: **Session 1 9am:** You MUST be on the tennis court top area for 8.50am – Register P1 & go (do not wait for end of registration).
Session 2 1pm: You MUST be on the tennis court top area for 12.45pm – if you have an exam, you will have lunch at 12.00.
- If you are entitled to extra time, your exam will take place in N8 to avoid you being disturbed when others leave.
- You will enter the examination hall by candidate number (mostly alphabetically ordered) – this has been/will be discussed with you.
- Please ensure that all equipment is in a clear plastic bag/pencil case or loose in your hand. Calculators should NOT have the case/cover on – please remove them.
- Mobile phones must be handed in when entering the examination hall. From this year, new JCQ exam rules state that **NO WATCHES ARE PERMITTED IN THE EXAM ROOM.** Whereas previously these have just been removed and placed on desks, now you MUST remove your watch before entering the room. Wearing any kind of watch is now considered malpractice in the same way as mobile phones, smart watches and other electronic devices.
- Water (only) should be in a clear, unlabelled plastic bottle. Food is not permitted in the examination hall.
- You should not enter the Ruscoe Centre or Lamont Centre – please use the toilets attached to the Stanier Hall ONLY.
